# **I.4 Club Safety Plans**

## **Objective:**

Clubs develop and maintain appropriate risk assessment, safety documents and procedures for their location and activities.

Clubs need to review the guidance from British Rowing and other external bodies and develop a risk assessment together with plans and procedures that adequately address all the risks they face.

Clubs have a duty to establish a positive safety culture amongst their members and should have the following documents in place:

- Risk assessments and safety plans
- Emergency response plans
- Communication protocols and assurance procedures to confirm members are aware of and comply with all the club requirements

## Responsibilities

#### **Everyone**

- Ensures they are aware of all the club regulations and safety advice.
- Demonstrates a positive safety culture approach.
- Ensures they prioritise safety at all times.
- Personally follows all the club safety recommendations.
- Intervenes whenever they witness any potentially unsafe acts by others.

#### **British Rowing / Honorary Rowing Safety Adviser**

- Provides advice and support to regions and clubs developing safety plans.
- Ensures British Rowing employees understand and follow all club safety requirements / advice when working with clubs.

### Regional Rowing Council / Regional Rowing Safety Adviser

Provides advice and support to individual clubs developing their safety plans.

#### Club / Club Rowing Safety Advisor

- Develops and maintains a risk based safety plan including emergency response procedures and communication protocols.
- Ensures members are aware of all the club requirements and advice including:
  - Specific regulations for boating in inclement weather
  - o Competency requirements for critical roles and activities e.g. steering, lone sculling
  - o Maintenance of records of safety training, competence assessments etc.
  - o Requirements for safety equipment

#### Coach / Responsible Person

Ensures all activities under their control / leadership follow club safety requirements and advice.
